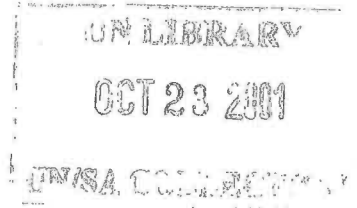

JOINT COMMUNIQUE

**on the establishment of the diplomatic relations
between Malta and the Republic of Sierra Leone**

The Government of Malta and the Government of the Republic of Sierra Leone guided by their desire to strengthen and develop bilateral co-operation between the two countries in accordance with the purposes and principles of the charter of the United Nations and of international law have decided to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level on this day.

The Parties to this agreement agree that the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of the 18th of April 1961, shall apply to diplomatic relations between them.

The two Parties further agree that their consular relations shall be guided by the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 24 April, 1963.

Signed in New York on the 16th October, 2001.
