BUDGET ESTIMATES FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 1957

Revised Estimates for Section 3

Ad Hoc Committee of Experts in the Field of Prevention  
of Crime and the Treatment of Offenders

(Note by the Secretary-General)

1. The Committee met for the first time in 1953 at Headquarters, pursuant to the provision of General Assembly resolution 415 (V). It has been meeting biennially and the 1957 session has been scheduled for Geneva from 5 to 9 August, immediately following the summer session of the Economic and Social Council.
2. It will be necessary to provide for the travel and subsistence expenses of the five experts, who will be travelling from Mexico, the United States of America, Egypt, Pakistan and Italy. The travel expenses are estimated at \$3,550 and the subsistence expenses (\$20 a day) at \$800, for a total of \$4,350. The travel and subsistence expenses of one substantive staff member from Headquarters who will be servicing the meeting are estimated at \$1,000. The Geneva Office will provide the necessary services for this meeting from the regular establishment.
3. These expenses would fall under Section 3 (Chapter XI) of the 1957 budget estimates, and the Secretary-General accordingly revises his estimates for this Section from \$141,050 (\$139,950 in A/3126 and \$1,100 in A/C.5/663) to \$146,400.
