## BUDGET ESTIMATES FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 1959

## Revised Estimate for Section 1 Resulting from Decisions of the Trusteeship Council

(Report of the Secretary-General)

- 1. At its 933rd meeting, the Trusteeship Council decided to dispatch two Visiting Missions to Trust Territories in the Pacific in 1959, one to Western Samoa and the other to Nauru, New Guinea and the Pacific Islands.
- 2. Section 1 of the 1959 budget estimates contains a sum of \$61,500 for one Visiting Mission to Trust Territories in the Pacific. The cost of two missions is estimated at approximately \$77,500, an increase of \$16,000.
- 3. Accordingly, the Secretary-General's budget estimate for 1959 under Section 1, Chapter IV (The Trusteeship Council, Commissions and Committees) is now revised from the present total of \$63,500 to a total of \$79,500 to provide as follows:
  - (a) For two Visiting Missions to Trust Territories in the Pacific: \$77,500
  - (b) For the extension into 1959 of the activities of the 1958 Visiting Mission to the Cameroons: \$ 2,000
