QUESTION OF SOUTH WEST AFRICA

Report of the United Nations Good Offices Committee On
South West Africa

Statement of financial implications
submitted by the Secretary-General

1. The draft resolution adopted by the Fourth Committee at its 769th meeting (A/C.4/L.538) invites the Good Offices Committee on South West Africa, established by General Assembly resolution 1143 (XII), to renew discussions with the Government of the Union of South Africa and requests it to submit a further report to the General Assembly at its fourteenth session. The draft resolution further requests the Secretary-General to continue to provide the Good Offices Committee with the necessary staff and facilities.
2. Assuming that the programme of work of the Committee parallels that for 1958, - namely, one meeting either at New York or London, one visit to South West Africa, and a further meeting during the fourteenth session of the General Assembly, - the required budgetary provision would be the same as that authorized for 1958. The 1958 authorized amount under Section 4 of the Budget is \$26,000, of which \$12,000 relates to travel and subsistence of members, \$12,000 to travel and subsistence of staff, and \$2,000 to miscellaneous expenses.
