> APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF SUBSIDIARY BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

> UNITED NATIONS ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. By resolution 1079 (XI), the General Assembly appointed, <u>inter alia</u>, Mr. Jacob Mark Lashly (United States of America) as a member of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal for a three-year term to commence on 1 January 1957.
- 2. By a cable dated 6 October 1958, the President of the Administrative Tribunal notified the Secretary-General of the resignation by Mr. Lashly from membership in the Tribunal.
- 3. In his note A/3842, the Secretary-General informed the General Assembly of the expiration of the terms of office, on 31 December 1958, of three of the members of the Administrative Tribunal. In view of the resignation of Mr. Lashly, it is thus necessary for the General Assembly at its thirteenth session to appoint, in addition to three persons to fill the vacancies resulting from the expiration of regular terms of office, one person to fill the unexpired portion of the term of office of Mr. Lashly.
