## RESOLUTIONS ON PETITIONS ADOPTED BY THE TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION NO. 4: PETITIONS CONCERNING AN INTERNATIONAL CONTROL AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE POLAR REGIONS BY THE TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL.

THE TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL has, at its second session, in conformity with its Rules of Procedure, considered the following petitions:

1. Petition from the Women's International League for Peace and Freedom, Geneva, Switzerland, dated 2 June 1947 (document T/PET/GENERAL 15).
2. Petition from the Women's International League for Peace and Freedom, Copenhagen, Denmark, dated 30 August 1947 (document T/PET/GENERAL 16).
3. Petition from the Women's International League for Peace and Freedom, Helsinki, Finland, dated 13 September 1947 (document T/PET/GENERAL 18).
