- I/ The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on the report on the Pattern of Conferences (A/C.5/769) have still to be considered.
- 2/ The report of the Secretary-General (A/3864, Add.1) on the strengthening and widening of scientific activities in the field of the effects of atomic radiation is under consideration in the First Committee.
- At its 590th meeting, the Sixth Committee adopted a draft resolution (A/C.6/L.442) requesting the Secretary-General to convoke during July or August 1959, a Second International Conference on the Law of the Sea. The Advisory Committee and the Fifth Committee have still to consider the Secretary-General's report on the financial implications (A/C.6/L.441).
- The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on the report of the Secretary-General (A/C.5/770) have still to be considered.
- At its 665th meeting, the Fifth Committee approved a global provision of \$25,000 for the implementation of ECOSOC resolution 690 C (XXVI). The Secretary-General proposes a distribution of this amount between Section 6 (\$20,000) and Section 7 (\$5,000).
- The action of the Fourth Committee on the invitation of the Fifth Committee at its 695th meeting is pending (A/C.5/761, A/3998).

The approved recommendations of the Fifth Committee at its 700th meeting, on the question of pensionable remuneration of the staff (A/C.5/760, A/5938, 4018) involve budgetary provisions (a) of \$95,000 under Section 7 in respect of an increase by 5 per cent of the pensionable remuneration of the professional category and higher salary levels; and (b) of \$9,400 under Section 8 for the United Nations Share in 1959, of the costs of an Expert Committee.

Pending consideration by the Fifth Committee of the Report of the Expert Committee on Public Information Activities, a provision of \$27,220 included in the 1959 estimates for Section 13, in respect of equipment for public information activities was deleted (A/3860, para. 200).
