APPOINTMENT OF A COMMITTEE TO JOIN REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL IN ANY FUTURE NEGOTIATIONS
WITH INTER-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS TO BE BROUGHT
INTO RELATIONSHIP WITH THE UNITED NATIONS

Memorandum Prepared by the Secretariat

At its first session, on 23 April 1947, the Trusteeship Council adopted the following resolution:*

THE TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL

RESOLVES that the President of the Trusteeship Council be authorized to appoint, in response to the invitation extended and for the period of one year, a committee of one to three representatives of the Trusteeship Council to join, with respect to clauses concerning the Trusteeship Council, the representatives of the Economic and Social Council in any future negotiations with inter-governmental organizations to be brought into relationship with the United Nations, in accordance with Articles 57 and 63 of the Charter.

On 28 April 1947, the President announced that, in pursuance of the resolution, he was appointing the representatives of Australia and Mexico as members of the Committee. The appointments expired therefore on 27 April 1948.

Negotiations are expected to take place within the next few months with a view to bringing the Inter-Governmental Maritime Consultative Organization into relationship with the United Nations.
