Upon the request of the delegation of the Union oi Soviet Socialist Republics the following corrections should be made in document míano of 26 July $1948:$

Page 1, line ll, delete the word "Executive".
Page l, line 13, delete the word "Executive".
Page 1, instead of lines 20-24 "The Belgian representative ......
up to ..... liberty (T/PT.87, p. 24 ) " $^{\prime \prime}$, insert the following sentences:
"The Representative of Belgium speaking on corporal punishment In Tanganyika stated inter ali: '.....there are factors which explain why corporal punishment should be applied to the indigenous inhabitants and not to the Europeans. The main reasons are these: Irprisomment is e real punishment for Europeans and often is not a real punishment for natives. There are natives whose living standard at home when they are at liberty is certainly much lower than the standard of living of a prisoner. For these natives prison is not a punishment, nor is prison a subject of shame for them.

The native has no fear of going to prison because he sees in it no diminution - and there is no diminution - in his social status resulting from his having been in prison.'" (m/P.V.87, pp. 25-31).

Page 5, line 25, read instead of "young people" - "juveniles".
