PROPOSAL FOR HOLDING THE SIXTH SESSION OF THE
TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL AT GENEVA

Financial estimates presented by the Secretary-General in accordance
with Rule 65 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council

If the Council decides that its January 1950 session be held at Geneva, the total costs over and above the provisions made in the 1950 budget estimates are estimated as follows:

<u>Duration</u>	<u>With Verbatim Reports</u>	<u>Without Verbatim Reporters</u>
10 weeks	\$56,590	\$40,290

All the above estimates include \$2,000 for communication services, \$1,000 for freight, \$3,750 for rental and maintenance of simultaneous interpretation equipment. The remainder of the totals cover travel and subsistence allowance of staff members to be detailed from New York. The various estimates take into account a saving of \$2,400 for local transportation as no local transportation will be provided in Geneva.
