PETITION FROM THE TANGANYIKA AFRICAN ASSOCIATION
CONCERNING TANGANYIKAResolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council
at the forty-eighth meeting, on 25 March 1949

THE TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL, acting under Article 87 b of the Charter, has, at its fourth session, in conformity with its rules of procedure, accepted and examined in consultation with the United Kingdom as the Administering Authority concerned, a petition from the Tanganyika African Association dated 20 September 1948 (T/PET.2/61).

The Council took note of the observations on the petition of the United Nations Mission to East Africa (T/218, T/218/Add.1).

THE TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL

HAVING NOTED that the petition raises questions of a general character concerning conditions in Tanganyika;

HAVING NOTED that these questions are dealt with in the report of the United Nations Mission to East Africa;

HAVING DECIDED to postpone the final examination of the report of the Mission until its fifth session;

DECIDED that the questions of a general character raised in the petition will be dealt with in conjunction with the final examination of the report of the Mission;

REQUESTS the Secretary-General to communicate to the petitioners any subsequent decisions which the Council may adopt on these questions, together with the relevant parts of its official records;

INVITES the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the petitioners of this decision in accordance with rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
