PETITION FROM MR. W. K. AMEGBE
CONCERNING TCGOLAND UNDER BRITISH ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council
at the twenty-ninth meeting, on 22 July 1949

The Trusteeship Council, acting under Article 87 b of the Charter, has, at its fifth session, in conformity with its rules of procedure, accepted and examined, in consultation with the United Kingdom as the Administering Authority concerned, a petition from Mr. W. K. Amegbe dated 16 November 1948 (T/PET.6/13).

The Council took note of the statement by the representative of the Administering Authority concerned that the courts of the Territory were competent to deal with the case of the petitioner.

THE TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL,

HAVING CONSIDERED the statement by the representative of the Administering Authority,

DECIDES to inform the petitioner that, if he wishes to seek redress, he should do so in the local courts;

DECIDES to suggest to the Administering Authority that it should inform the petitioner of such facilities as may be available to him, if he decides to seek redress in the local courts;

INVITES the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the petitioner of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
