PETITION FROM MWAMBUTSA, THE MWAMI OF URUNDI,
CONCERNING RUANDA-URUNDI AND TANGANYIKAResolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the
forty-eighth meeting, on 25 March 1949

THE TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL, acting in accordance with Article 87 b of the Charter, has, at its fourth session, in conformity with its rules of procedure, accepted and examined, in consultation with Belgium and the United Kingdom as the Administering Authorities concerned, a petition from Mwambutsa, the Mwami of Urundi, dated 25 July 1948 (T/PET.2/49-T/PET.3/5).

The Council took note of the observations of the United Nations Visiting Mission to East Africa on the petition, and of the observations of the Local Authorities (T/217/Add.1).

The Council took note of statements by the representatives of the Administering Authorities concerned that their Governments were holding consultations on the question raised in the petition.

THE TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL

HAVING NOTED the statements by the representatives of the Administering Authorities,

DECIDES that no action by the Council is called for at the present time on the petition;

INVITES the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authorities and the petitioner of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
