PETITION FROM MR. A.J. SIGGINS CONCERNING TANGANYIKA

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the forty-eighth meeting, on 25 March 1949

The Trusteeship Council, acting under Article 87 b of the Charter, has, at its fourth session, in conformity with its rules of procedure, accepted and examined, in consultation with the United Kingdom as the Administering Authority concerned, an undated petition from Mr. A.J. Siggins (T/PET.2/55 and T/PET.2/55/Add.1).

The Council considered the petitioner's request for an oral presentation in support of his written petition, and decided not to grant that request.

The Trusteeship Council,

Having considered the statements of the representative of the Administering Authority and the observations of the Chairman of the United Nations Mission to East Africa,

Decides that no action by the Council is called for on this petition;

Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority
and the petitioner of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the
rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
