PETITION FROM MRS. KÄTE SALZMANN
CONCERNING TANGANYIKA

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council
at the twenty-ninth meeting, on 22 July 1949

The Trusteeship Council, acting under Article 87 b of the Charter, has at its fifth session, in conformity with its rules of procedure, accepted and examined in consultation with the United Kingdom as the Administering Authority concerned a petition from Mrs. Käte Salzmann, dated 6 December 1948 (T/PET.2/63).

The Council took note of the observations of the Administering Authority concerned (T/343), in which it stated that its action on the petitioner's case was in accordance with its repatriation policy which had been approved by the Trusteeship Council during its first session^{1/}.

THE TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL,

HAVING CONSIDERED the observations presented by the Administering Authority on this petition,

DECIDES that no action by the Council is called for on this petition;

INVITES the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the petitioner of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
