PETITION FROM THE MANDA-NKWE COMMUNITY
CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UPDER HRIPISH ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the eightieth meeting on 3 April 1950

Acting

under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with its rules of procedure,

Having accepted and examined, at its Sixth Session, the petition from the Manda-Nkwe community (T/PET.4/33), in consultation with the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland as the Administering Authority concerned, which designated Brigadier Gibbons as special representative,

Having taken note of the observations of the Administering Authority concerned (T/499, paras. 4 to 8) as well as of the statement of the special representative, that the petition laid before the Trusteeship Council a case with which the courts have competence to deal.

The Trusteeship Council

Decides

to inform the petitioners that if they wish to seek redress, they should do so in the local courts;

Invites

the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the petitioners of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
