PETITION FROM MR. MANUEL MARIA DO RIO  
CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER FRENCH  
ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the  
eightieth meeting on 3 April 1950

Acting under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with its rules  
of procedure,

Having accepted and examined, at its sixth session, the petition from  
Mr. Manuel Maria Do Rio (T/PET.5/11) in consultation with France  
as the Administering Authority concerned, which designated  
Mr. Watier as special representative.

Having taken note of the statement by the special representative that the  
petitioner had re-entered the Trust Territory of the Cameroons under  
French administration illegally and was an undesirable character,

Having further noted that a period of grace had been granted to the petitioner  
to enable him to settle his affairs before expulsion,

The Trusteeship Council

Decides that no action by the Council is called for on this petition;

Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority  
and the petitioner of this resolution in accordance with  
rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
