PETITION FROM THE EX-SERVICEMEN'S UNION
CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER
BRITISH ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the
eightieth meeting on 3 April 1950

Acting under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with
its rules of procedure,

Having accepted and examined at its sixth session the petition from the
Ex-Servicemen's Union, (T/PET.4/18), in consultation with the
United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland as the
Administering Authority concerned, which designated
Brigadier Gibbons as special representative,

Having taken note of the observations of the Administering Authority (T/489)
and the statement of the Special Representative to the effect

that strenuous efforts have been and continue to be made by
the Administering Authority to help home-coming servicemen,

The Trusteeship Council

Expresses the hope that such efforts be continued and, if necessary,
increased, so that any legitimate grievance on the part of the
ex-servicemen, may eventually be met;

Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority
and the petitioners of this resolution in accordance with rule 93
of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
