> PETITION FROM BONJONGO GROUP CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER BRITISH ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council

at the eightieth meeting on 3 April 1950

Acting under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with its rules of procedure,

- Having accepted and examined, at its sixth session, the petition from the Bonjongo Group (T/PET.4/3/Add.5), in consultation with the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland as the Administering Authority concerned, which designated Brigadier Gibbons as special representative,
- <u>Having taken note</u> of the observations of the United Nations Visiting Mission to West Africa on the question of land (T/46 pp. 96 and 97),
- Having taken note of the observations of the Administering Authority concerned, (T/182/Add.3, and T/486 para. 34), as well as of the oral statement of the special representative on this petition,

Having noted

Having noted the statement of the Administering Authority that the Roman Catholic Mission was willing to consider the possibility of exchanging the land held at Bonjongo for parcels of land in other parts of the Territory provided that the Bonjongo land would be

The Trusteeship Council

<u>Invites</u> the Administering Authority to enter into discussions with representatives of the Roman Catholic Mission at Bonjongo in order to devise a scheme which may lead to the ameliorations of the land situation in this particular area;

included in the Bakweri resettlement programme,

<u>Invites</u> the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the petitioners of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
