Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the
eightieth meeting on 3 April 1950

Acting under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with its
rules of procedure,

Having accepted and examined at its sixth session the petition from
Mr. V. Loko (T/PET.4/34), in consultation with the United Kingdom
of Great Britain and Northern Ireland as the Administering Authority
concerned, which designated Brigadier Gibbons as special
representative,

Having taken note of the observations of the Administering Authority concerned
(T/510) as well as of the oral statement of the special
representative on this petition,

Having noted the statement of the special representative concerning the fact
that a criminal conviction disqualified employees from receiving
gratuities or pensions,

The Trusteeship Council

Decides that no action by the Council is called for on this petition;
Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the
petitioner of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the
rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
