

PETITION FROM CHIEF M. M. CAFORGBE CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER BRITISH ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the eightieth meeting on 3 April 1950

Acting under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with its rules of procedure,

Having accepted and examined, at its sixth session the petition from Chief M.M.Gaforgbe (T/PET.4/53) in consultation with the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland as the Administering Authority concerned, which designated Brigadier Gibbons as special representative.

Having taken note of the observations of the Administering Authority concerned (T/516) as well as of the oral statement of the special representative on this petition,

Having noted the statement of the Administering Authority that the grievance of the petitioner was the result of a misapprehension on his part and that his gratuity had, in fact, already been paid to him in full,

The Trusteeship Council

Refers the matter to the Administering Authority with a request that the misunderstanding be explained to the petitioner;

Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the petitioner of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
