PETITION FROM MR. SAMUEL MOSENJAMO NJAKO

CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER

BRITISH ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the eightieth meeting on 3 April 1950

Acting under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with its rules of procedure,

Having accepted and examined at its sixth session the petition from Mr. Samuel Mosenjamo Njako (T/PET.4/17) in consultation with the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland as the Administering Authority concerned, which designated Brigadier Gibbons as special representative.

Having taker note of the observations of the Administering Authority (T/490) in which it stated that the petition laid before the Trusteeship Council a case with which the courts had competence to deal,

The Trusteeship Council

Decides to inform the petitioner that, if he wishes to seek redress, he should do so in the local courts;

Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the petitioner of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
