PETITION FROM THE COLLECTIVITE DE BONAMIKENGUE-AKWA-DOUALA  
CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER FRENCH ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the  
eightieth Meeting on 3 April 1950

Acting under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with  
its rules of procedure,

Having accepted and examined, at its sixth session the petition from the  
Collectivité de Bonamikengue-Akwa-Douala (T/PET.5/59), in  
consultation with France as the Administering Authority  
concerned, which designated Mr. Laurentie as special  
representative,

Having taken note of the oral statement of the special representative on  
this petition,

Having noted the statement of the Administering Authority that the dispute  
set forth in the petition had been referred to the Ngondo, the  
traditional Assembly of people, and that the latter had so far  
failed to reach a conclusion on this question,

The Trusteeship Council

Expresses the hope that the Administering Authority will do everything in  
its power to hasten the achievement of a satisfactory solution;

Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and  
the petitioners of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of  
the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
