QUESTION OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A GOVERNMENT STATION AS RAISED IN
THE PETITION FROM THE ASSUMBO NATIVE AUTHORITY

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the
eightieth meeting on 3 April 1950

Acting under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with its rules
of procedure,

Having accepted and examined, at its sixth session, in consultation with the
United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland as the
Administering Authority concerned, which designated Brigadier
Gibbons as special representative, the part of the petition from
the Assumbo Native Authority (T/PET.4/44) which raises the
question of the establishment of a government station,

Having taken note of the oral statement of the special representative on this
subject,

Having noted the assurance of the Administering Authority that all possible
steps are taken for the general development of the area of the
Assumbo Native Authority,

The Trusteeship Council

- (1) Expresses the hope that the Administering Authority will take all possible
measures to develop this part of the Trust Territory;
- (2) Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and
the petitioners of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of
the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
