PETITION FROM THE CONFEDERATION GENERALE DU TRAVAIL - FORCE OUVRIERE  
CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER FRENCH ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at  
the eightieth Meeting on 3 April 1950

- Acting under Article 87(b) of the Charter and in accordance with its rules of procedure,
- Having accepted and examined, at its sixth session, the petition from the Confédération générale du Travail - Force ouvrière (T/PET.5/50) in consultation with France as the Administering Authority concerned, which designated Mr. Watier as special representative,
- Having taken note of the oral statement of the special representative on this petition,
- Having noted the statement of the Administering Authority that it had agreed to put new Trade-Union Houses at the disposal of the Force Ouvrière and the Confederation of Christian Workers respectively, as soon as the budgetary position would permit,
- The Trusteeship Council
- Recommends that the Administering Authority continue to take steps to ensure that all forms of trade-unionism be allowed to develop freely;
- Expresses the hope that the Administering Authority will take all possible steps to accommodate the trade unionism in the area with regard to their building requirements;
- Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the petitioners of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
