PETITION FROM THE CONFEDERATION GENERALE DU TRAVAIL - FORCE OUVRIERE CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER FRENCH ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the eightieth Meeting on 3 April 1950

Acting under Article 87(b) of the Charter and in accordance with its rules of procedure.

Having accepted and examined, at its sixth session, the petition from the Confdestation generale du Travail - Force ouvrière (T/PET.5/50) in consultation with France as the Administering Authority concerned, which designated Mr. Watier as special representative,

Having taken note of the oral statement of the special representative on this petition,

Having noted the statement of the Administering Authority that it had agreed to put new Trade-Union Houses at the disposal of the Force

Ouvrière and the Confederation of Christian Workers respectively, as soon as the budgetary position would permit,

The Trusteeship Council

Recommends that the Administering Authority continue to take steps to ensure that all forms of trade-unionism be allowed to develop freely;

Expresses the hope that the Administering Authority will take all possible steps to accommodate the trade unionism in the area with regard to their building requirements;

Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the petitioners of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
