> PETITION FROM THE FON OF BALL AND BALL NATIVE AUTHORITY CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER BRITISH ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the eightisth Meeting on 3 April 1950

Acting

under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with its rules of procedure,

Having accepted and examined, at its sixth session, the petition from the Fon of Bali and Bali Native Authority (T/PET.\$/43) in consultation with the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland as the Administering Authority concerned, which designated Brigadier Gibbons as special representative,

Having taken note of the oral statement of the special representative on this petition,

<u>Having noted</u> the assurance of the Administering Authority that no discrimination among various tribal groups is allowed by the local Administration,

The Trusteeship Council

Expresses the hope that in dealing with different tribal groups the Administering Authority will continue its policy of equaltreatment;

Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the petitioners of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
