PETITION FROM THE FON OF BALI AND BALI NATIVE AUTHORITY
CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER BRITISH ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the
eightieth Meeting on 3 April 1950

- Acting under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with its rules of procedure,
- Having accepted and examined, at its sixth session, the petition from the Fon of Bali and Bali Native Authority (T/PET.5/43) in consultation with the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland as the Administering Authority concerned, which designated Brigadier Gibbons as special representative,
- Having taken note of the oral statement of the special representative on this petition,
- Having noted the assurance of the Administering Authority that no discrimination among various tribal groups is allowed by the local Administration,
- The Trusteeship Council
- Expresses the hope that in dealing with different tribal groups the Administering Authority will continue its policy of equal treatment;
- Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the petitioners of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
