

THE QUESTION OF TRAINING OF MISSIONARIES
AS RAISED IN THE PETITION FROM THE CAMEROONS
FEDERAL UNION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the eightieth meeting on 3 April 1950

Acting under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with its rules of procedure,

Having accepted and examined, at its sixth session in consultation with the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, as the Administering Authority concerned, which designated Brigadier Gibbons as special representative, the part of the petition from the Cameroons Federal Union (T/PET.4/61-5/66) which raises the question of training of missionaries,

Having noted that the question raised is the responsibility of voluntary agencies,

The Trusteeship Council

- (1) <u>Decides</u> to inform the petitioners that no action by the Council is called for on this question;
- (2) <u>Invites</u> the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the petitioners of this resolution in accordance with Rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
