QUESTION OF CONSTRUCTION OF AN AIRFIELD AT
BESONGABANG, MONFORD DIVISION, AS RAISED BY
THE PETITION OF THE CAMEROONS FEDERAL UNION
CONCERNING CAMEROONS UNDER BRITISH ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the
eightieth meeting on 3 April 1950

Acting under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with its rules
of procedure,

Having accepted and examined, at its sixth session, in consultation with the
United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland as the
Administering Authority concerned, which designated Brigadier
Gibbons as special representative, the part of the petition from
the Cameroons Federal Union (T/PET.4/61 - 5/66) which raises the
question of the construction of an airfield at Besongabang,

Having noted the statement of the Administering Authority that compensation
had been paid as the result of a freely negotiated agreement and
that the persons directly concerned were not the petitioners,

The Trusteeship Council

- (1) Decides that no action by the Council is called for on this question;
- (2) Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and
the petitioners of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of
the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
