QUESTION OF HANDICRAFT AS RAISED IN CERTAIN
PETITIONS CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER
FRENCH ADMINISTRATION.

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the
eightieth meeting on 3 April 1950.

Acting under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with
its rules of procedure,

Having accepted and examined, at its sixth session in consultation with France,
as the Administering Authority concerned, which designated Mr.
Watier as special representative, parts of the following
petitions which raised the question of handicraft:

- (1) Petition from Mr. Michel Nguéguim (T/PET.5/34),
- (2) Petition from the Artisans de Dschang (T/PET.5/41),

Having taken note of the oral statement of the special representative on this
subject,

The Trusteeship Council

- (1) Invites the Administering Authority to give all possible assistance to
the indigenous inhabitants in the development and improvement of
handicrafts and to that end to consider the possibility of
reducing existing licence fees;
- (2) Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and
the petitioners of this resolution in accordance with rule 93
of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
