QUESTION OF PRICE FIXING AS RAISED IN THE  
PETITION FROM THE UNION DES SYNDICATS CONFEDERES DU CAMEROUN

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the  
eightieth meeting on 3 April 1950.

Acting under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with its rules of procedure,

Having accepted and examined, at its sixth session, in consultation with France as the administering Authority concerned, which designated Mr. Watier as special representative, the part of the petition from the Union des Syndicats Confédérés du Cameroun (T/PET.5/52) which raises the question of price fixing,

Having taken note of the oral statement of the special representative on this subject,

Having noted the statement of the Administering Authority that the situation described in this part of the petition no longer exists,

The Trusteeship Council

- (1) Decides that no action by the Council is called for on this question;
- (2) Invites the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the petitioners of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
