

QUESTION OF LIBERATION OF WOMEN AS RAISED IN CERTAIN PETITIONS CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER FRENCH ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the Trusteeship Council at the eightieth meeting on 3 April 1950

Acting

under Article 87 (b) of the Charter and in accordance with its rules of procedure.

- Having accepted and examined, at its sixth session, in consultation with France as the Administering Authority concerned, which designated Mr. Watier as special representative, parts of the following petitions which raise the question of the liberation of women:
 - (1) Petition from the Vicariat Apostolique Douala, Cameroun (T/PET.5/45)
 - (2) Petition from the Evolution Sociale Camerounaise (T/PET.5/54)
 - (3) Petition from the Comité Féminin de 11Union des Populations du Cameroun: (T/PET.5/60-4/32)

Having taken note of the oral statement of the special representative on this subject,

Having noted the assurance of the Administering Authority that it is its policy to ensure the improvement of the social status of women in the Territory,

The Trusteeship Council

(1) Expresses the hope that the Administering Authority will make efforts

(2) Invites

to improve the social status of women in the Territory; the Secretary-General to inform the Administering Authority and the petitioners of this resolution in accordance with rule 93 of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council.
