EXAMINATION OF PETITIONS

PETITION FROM THE COMMUNAL DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, KPANDU
CONCERNING TOGOLAND UNDER BRITISH ADMINISTRATION

Observations of the Administering Authority

Note by the Secretariat: The following observations were communicated to the Secretariat on 22 May 1950 by the representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland on the Trusteeship Council.

The membership of the petitioning "Commission" is not known to the Gold Coast Government.

Paragraph 234 of the Annual Report on Togoland under United Kingdom Trusteeship for 1948 gives details of the Mass Education campaign organised by the Administering Authority in the later part of that year. The Visiting Mission in the last section of its report (T/465) has commented favourably on the mass education experiment being carried on in the Territory and on a course at Kpandu itself. As stated in the comments of the Administering Authority on the report of the Mission, steps are being taken to ensure that the work goes on without interruption.
