ON THE CONSERVATION OF THE LIVING RESOURCES OF THE SEA

Report of the Credentials Committee

Chairman: Jorge Castañeda (Mexico)

1. At its Third Plenary Meeting held on 19 April 1955, the International Technical Conference on the Conservation of the Living Resources of the Sea, in accordance with Rule 3 of its Rules of Procedure, appointed a Credentials Committee consisting of the following States:

Brazil, Canada, Egypt, Indonesia, Japan, Mexico, Netherlands, Poland and the Union of South Africa.

2. The Committee held two meetings on 22 and 27 April 1955.

3. Mr. Jorge Castañeda (Mexico) was unanimously elected Chairman of the Committee.

4. The Committee found that the Governments of the following States had submitted to the Executive Secretary credentials for their representatives satisfying the requirements of Rule 2 of the Rules of Procedure of the Conference:
