Financial and administrative implications of the draft resolution
contained in document A/C.5/L.1065/Rev.1

1. The financial and administrative implications for 1972, in terms of subparagraphs (a), (b), (c) and (d) of the operative paragraph of the draft resolution contained in document A/C.5/L.1065/Rev.1, are given in annexes I to II attached under each chapter of section 3 and under the section as a whole.
2. With regard to subparagraph (b), information is not at this time available as to the number of staff employed by overseas offices as of 15 November 1971, within credits approved under chapter V. For the purpose of this paragraph, therefore, the position shown is as of 31 October 1971.

The effect of the further reduction shown above would be to decrease the recommendations of the Advisory Committee under section 4, Common staff costs, by \$148,500. Similarly, income from staff assessment under income section 1, would be reduced by \$150,000.
