ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF UNDER-DEVELOPED COUNTRIES
INDUSTRIALIZATION OF UNDER-DEVELOPED COUNTRIES

Pakistan: draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Bearing in mind the importance of a programme of rapid industrialization in the less developed countries as a factor in the balanced development of their economies,

Noting the steps taken by the Economic and Social Council in its resolutions 597 (XXI) and 618 (XXII) to promote such a programme,

Believing that the question of machinery for this purpose should be kept under review in the light of the development of the programme of work in this field by the United Nations,

1. Endorses resolution 597 (XXI) of the Economic and Social Council which, inter alia, reaffirms the special responsibilities of the Council for the promotion and co-ordination of activities in the field of accelerated industrialization and productivity of less developed countries as an essential element of balanced development programmes;

2. Requests the Secretary-General in the implementation of the programme of work on industrialization and productivity to give due regard to the various suggestions made at the twenty-second session of the Economic and Social Council and the eleventh regular session of the General Assembly and to the directives and principles set forth in the relevant resolutions of the General Assembly and the Council;

3. Requests the Secretary-General, in pursuance of resolution 618 (XXII) of the Economic and Social Council, to report on the question of machinery necessary in the field of industrialization to the twenty-fifth session of the Council.
