REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND SCCIAL COUNCIL

Bases for International Economic Co-operation

Mexico: draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Considering that the strengthening and development of international economic co-operation is, under the Charter, one of the most important means available to the United Nations for the promotion of peaceful relations among peoples;

Recalling that the General Assembly and the Economic and Social Council have on several occasions adopted resolutions embodying various principles relating to international economic co-operation;

Taking into account that a large number of countries have recently been admitted to membership in the United Nations and consequently were not represented in the debates on those resolutions;

Considering also, that in view of the proposals and opinions submitted and expressed before the General Assembly at its twelfth session, it would be useful for all Member States to have at their disposal a compendium of those principles;

Requests the Secretary-General to prepare such a compendium of resolutions or extracts from them, with a subject index, to facilitate study of the resolutions, and to transmit it as soon as it is prepared, to all Member States.
