## REPORT OF THE AGENT GENERAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS KOREAN RECONSTRUCTION AGENCY

Canada, United Kingdom and United States: joint draft resolution

### The General Assembly,

Recalling General Assembly resolutions 410 (V) of 1 December 1950, 701 (VII) of 11 March 1953, 725 (VIII) of 7 December 1953, 828 (IX) of 14 December 1954, 920 (X) of 25 October 1955 and 1020 (XI) of 2 December 1956,

#### Taking note:

- (a) of the Report of the Agent-General on the Work of the United Nations Korean Reconstruction Agency for the period 1 July 1956 to 30 June 1957, and of the comments thereon by the United Nations Commission for the Unification and Rehabilitation of Korea;
  - (b) of the addendum to the Agent-General's report, dated 31 October 1957;
- (c) of the Memorandum of the Agent-General to the Advisory Committee dated 11 November 1957,

Recognizing the especial importance of the Agency's programme for the relief and rehabilitation of the Republic of Korea,

- 1. <u>Commends</u> the Agent-General of the United Nations Korean Reconstruction Agency for the excellent work performed by the Agency in pursuing its mission of assisting the Korean people to relieve the sufferings and to repair the devastation caused by aggression;
- 2. Expresses its conviction that the work of the Agency will have longlasting and significant effects upon the economy of Korea and upon the wellbeing of the Korean people;

- 3. Expresses appreciation for the valuable assistance given to the Agency by United Nations specialized agencies and by voluntary non-governmental organizations;
- 4. Approves the recommendation of the Agent-General that the Agency cease as an operational organization on 30 June 1958;
- 5. <u>Further approves</u> the arrangements and procedures proposed by the Agent-General in his Memorandum dated 11 November 1957 for the completion after 30 June 1958 of the residual responsibilities of the Agency and the subsequent liquidation of its accounts.
