Land-locked countries and the expansion of international trade

The General Assembly,

Recognizing the need of land-locked States and States having no access to the sea for adequate transit facilities in promoting international trade,

Urges Member Governments to give full recognition to the needs of land-locked Member States and Members having no access to the sea in the matter of transit trade and that adequate facilities therefore be accorded in terms of international law and practice in this regard.
