RESOLUTION OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Canada: Second revised amendment to Canadian draft resolution (A/C.1/308)

This revised amendment is to replace the second part of paragraph 8 and the whole of paragraph 9 of document A/C.1/308, by the two following paragraphs, numbered 9 and 10:

"9. The General Assembly expresses its deep concern at the impasse which has been reached in the work of the Atomic Energy Commission as shown in its Third Report and regrets that unanimous agreement has not yet been reached.

"10. The General Assembly requests the six sponsors of the General Assembly resolution of 24 January 1946, who are the permanent members of the Atomic Energy Commission to meet together and consult in order to determine when there exists a basis for agreement on the international control of atomic energy to ensure its use only for peaceful purposes and for the elimination from national armaments of atomic weapons, and thereupon to request the Secretary-General to reconvene the United Nations Atomic Energy Commission, the activities of which have been suspended in order to resume its task, and in any event the sponsors shall report the results of their consultation not later than the next regular session of the General Assembly."
