THE FUTURE OF THE TRUST TERRITORIES OF THE CAMEROONS  
UNDER FRENCH ADMINISTRATION AND THE CAMEROONS UNDER  
UNITED KINGDOM ADMINISTRATION

Memorandum by the Secretary-General

1. The Secretary-General, in his memorandum of 24 February 1959 (A/C.4/396), brought to the attention of the members of the Fourth Committee 671 communications concerning general problems relating to the Cameroons under British administration and the Cameroons under French administration and concerning the future of these two Trust Territories.
2. The Secretary-General wishes to bring to the attention of the members of the Fourth Committee 1,019 additional communications concerning the two Trust Territories which, since 24 February 1959, have been circulated in the following documents, the majority of them having been grouped and summarized in accordance with paragraphs 4 and 6 of the annex to Trusteeship Council resolution 1713 (XX):
