INFORMATION FROM NON-SELF-GOVERNING TENHITORIES TRANSMITTED UNDER ARTICLE 73 e OF THE CHAPTER

Ceneral questions relating to the transmission and examination of information

- 1. By communication of 1 April 1958, the Prime Minister and Minister for External Affairs of Chana, in reply to the letter addressed to him dated 15 August 1957, described states that Ghana does not administer any Non-Self-Governing Territories.
- 2. The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs of Ghana states further that consideration is being given to the question of offering facilities for study and training to inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories and a communication on this subject will be addressed to the Secretary-General in due course.
- 3. By communication of 27 December 1957 the Minister of External Affairs of the Federation of Malaya, in reply to the letter addressed to him dated 1 October 1957, $\frac{1}{}$ states that there are no Territories referred to in Article 73 of the Charter of the United Nations for the administration of which the Government of the Federation of Malaya has responsibility.
