I have just returned from a trip to South West Africa with Mr. Allard K. Lowenstein and Mr. Emory F. Bundy. On this trip we endeavored to learn as much as was possible concerning the conditions of the country with respect to the indigenous peoples. I feel confident that our findings would be of interest to the Fourth Committee.

On the basis of these findings I hereby request permission for an oral hearing before the Fourth Committee.
