## REPORT OF THE TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL

Communications concerning the Cameroons under British administration  
and the Cameroons under French administrationMemorandum by the Secretary-General

1. Since June 1958, the Secretary-General has received 3,226 communications concerning general problems relating to the Cameroons under British administration and the Cameroons under French administration, and concerning the future of these two Trust Territories.
2. In accordance with paragraph 4 of the annex to Trusteeship Council resolution 1713 (XX), the particular questions raised in these communications have for the most part been summarized and grouped under appropriate headings in documents T/PET.4/L.11; T/PET.4 and 5/L.25 (65 communications), L.26 (100 communications), L.27 and Add.1, 2 and 3 (2,814 communications), L.28 and L.29; T/PET.5/L.455 (78 communications), L.456 (162 communications), L.457, L.458, L.459 and L.460.
3. It was not considered administratively practicable to reproduce these communications again as a General Assembly document, although in the great majority of cases they were addressed to the President of the General Assembly or to the Chairman of the Fourth Committee or else were addressed to the Secretary-General but referred to matters which are on the agenda of the present session of the General Assembly. The Secretary-General therefore asks the members of the Fourth Committee to bear them in mind when they consider the report of the Trusteeship Council.
