QUESTION OF SOUTH WEST AFRICA

Report of the Good Offices Committee on  
South West Africa

Resolution adopted by the Fourth Committee  
at its 777th meeting on 29 October 1958

The General Assembly,

Having invited the Good Offices Committee to renew discussions with the Government of the Union of South Africa to find a basis for an agreement which would continue to accord to the Mandated Territory of South West Africa as a whole an international status, and which would be in conformity with the principles and purposes of the United Nations,

Having requested the Good Offices Committee in the conduct of its work to bear fully in mind the discussions held at the thirteenth session of the General Assembly,

Keeping in view the vital importance of the question of South West Africa,

Believing that a verbatim record of Sub-Item (a) of Item 1 on the Agenda of the Fourth Committee will permit a proper understanding of the position of the United Nations on this question and will also facilitate the implementation of Resolution dated 22 October 1958 (A/C.4/L.538),

Requests the Secretary-General to have the verbatim record referred to above mimeographed and circulated.
