REPORT OF THE TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL

Effects of the European Economic Community on the
development of certain Trust Territories

Burma, Ceylon, Costa Rica, Czechoslovakia, Guatemala,
India, Indonesia, and the United Arab Republic:
draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Referring to resolution 1210 (XII) of 13 December 1957,

Noting with concern that the Administering Authorities have thus far
submitted no information on the possible effects of the association of the Trust
Territories under their administration with the European Economic Community,

Considering that the association of the Trust Territories with the European
Economic Community may have a significant impact upon their development towards
independence or self-government,

1. Requests again the Administering Authorities to include in their annual
reports information concerning the effects of the association with the European
Economic Community of the Trust Territories under their administration on the
economic development of these Territories and on their development towards
independence or self-government;

2. Requests the Trusteeship Council to examine this question at its next
session and to report to the fourteenth session of the General Assembly;

3. Resolves to resume consideration of this question at the fourteenth
session of the General Assembly.
