REPORT OF THE TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL

Economic aid for Somalia

India and Iraq: amendments to draft resolution submitted by Chile, the Philippines, Tunisia and Turkey (A/C.4/L.549)

1. Add the two following paragraphs to the Preamble:

"<u>Considering</u> that in its report on Somaliland, the mission of the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development stated that there would be much value in arrangements whereby financial and technical assistance could be administered in common to assure, on the one hand, independence and continuity and, on the other, the close co-ordination with government policies and administration without which assistance of both kinds could become ineffectual,

<u>Considering further</u> that the Prime Minister of the Government of Somalia suggested to the 1957 Visiting Mission to Trust Territories in East Africa that Members of the United Nations who might be in a position to contribute financial aid might do so through a United Nations Fund,"

2. Substitute for operative paragraph 4:

"4. <u>Requests</u> the Trusteeship Council to consider the prospects of further assistance from the Special Fund, the Expanded Programme of Technical Assistance and the specialized agencies, and to study the feasibility of establishing a Fund under United Nations auspices for channelling financial and technical assistance from Governments that are willing and in a position to offer such assistance and to study further the machinery for administering such a Fund and to report thereon to the fourteenth session of the General Assembly so that it may have a complete picture of the economic prospects of Somalia when it achieves independence in 1960."
