THE FUTURE OF TOGOLAND UNDER FRENCH ADMINISTRATION

Burma, Ceylon, Ghana, Guatemala, Haiti, India, Indonesia, the Philippines Syria, Uruguay and Yugoslavia; emendments to the revised draft resolution (A/C.4/L.508/Rev.1) submitted by Canada, Colombia, Denmark, Ireland and Liberia

1. In the fifth preambular paragraph:

- (a) Delete the word "additional" and substitute the word "all";
- (b) Insert after the words "Togoland Government" the words "except Defense, Diplomacy and Currency".
- 2. In operative paragraph 1: add the following words at the end:

 "and commends the observations and suggestions contained therein to the consideration of the Administering Authority and the Government of Togoland.".

3. In operative paragraph 4:

- (a) Delete the words "Requests the President of the General Assembly to appoint a Commissioner" and substitute the words "Decides to elect a Commission of three Members";
- (b) Replace the word "him" at the end by the word "it".
- 4. In operative paragraph 5: Replace the words "keep the United Nations Commissioner fully informed of the arrangements made" by the words "make in consultation with the United Nations Commission the arrangements".
- 5. <u>In operative paragraph 6</u>: replace the word "Commissioner" by the word "Commission" and insert the word "organization" before the word "conduct".

- 6. In operative paragraph 7: delete the words "termination of the Trusteeship Agreement for" and substitute the words "future of".
- 7. <u>In operative paragraph 8:</u> delete the words occurring after the words "so as to enable it" and substitute the words:

"to examine the entire situation in the light of the circumstances then prevailing, and to reach a decision concerning the attainment of the final objective of the International Trusteeship System and the consequent termination of the Trusteeship Agreement, in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations.".
