Request to UNESCO for an inquiry into facilities for
study and training

Chile and Ethiopia: draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Bearing in mind that the study and training facilities offered by Member States to the inhabitants of both Trust and Non-Self-Governing Territories represent only a very minor percentage of all those open internationally to students of all countries and which are listed in UNESCO's yearly publication "Study Abroad",

Noting that the debates on this matter have revealed the need for adequate co-ordination of the activities of responsible authorities of both the offering States and institutions and of the receiving Territories and peoples, and

Noting further that there still remain numerous unexplored sources of study and training facilities in all continents, such as the higher institutions of learning in Africa,

1. Requests UNESCO, as the technical specialized agency responsible for educational and related fields, to prepare a report on the matter of study and training facilities which are already directly offered or which might be made available from among those listed in "Study Abroad" or from other sources, to the inhabitants of Trust and Non-Self-Governing Territories, and on their most efficient use and administration;

2. Expresses the hope that such a report may be in hand with sufficient anticipation for its study at the fourteenth session of the General Assembly, and requests the Secretary-General to place this item on the provisional agenda thereof.
